Dear Misdemeanor and/or Felony Panelists,

It is important that the changes in visiting hours at the jail do not compromise your ability to provide a competent and effective defense for your client. It is therefore suggested that you consider the following:

- If you are on hearings or trial, ask the Judge for an order authorizing you to see your client outside the normal visiting hours.
- If you have a specific problem that requires you to see your client, call Acting Sheriff Michael Sposato at 571.4101 and ask him to authorize visitation outside of the normal visiting hours.
- If you are unable to get satisfaction from either of the above procedures, call me and I will do my best to deal with Acting Sheriff Sposato or Judge Donnino in order to solve the problem.
