

Hon. Steven M. Jaeger

Judge Steven M. Jaeger has served as a Judge of the County Court of Nassau County since January, 2005. He is currently an Acting Supreme Court Justice presiding over the Felony Treatment (Judicial Diversion) Court. He has also served in a Trial and Hearing Part, the Felony Domestic Violence Part and in Civil Term. Judge Jaeger was an Acting Family Court Judge during 2005 and served as a Nassau County District Court Judge from January, 2002 through 2004.

Judge Jaeger was admitted to the practice of law in New York in 1977, working in criminal defense and as an appellate counsel for the Legal Aid Society of the City of New York. From 1981 to 1984, he was Law Secretary to the Hon. Alexander Vitale in Nassau County Court and New York State Supreme Court. From 1984 through 1999 he was engaged in the private practice of law on Long Island and New York City. He served as Law Secretary to Nassau County Court Judge Meryl J. Berkowitz during 2000 to 2001.

Judge Jaeger is an active member of the Bar Association of Nassau County and is co-Chair of its Judicial Section. He serves on the Executive Committees of the New York State County Judges' Association and the Theodore Roosevelt American Inn of Court, as well as a member of the Board of Directors of the Jewish Lawyers Association of Nassau County. Judge Jaeger received his B.A. from the University of Pennsylvania and his J.D. from the NYU School of Law.
